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Board Members Present: Robert Wehrer, Val Riedel, Sidney Sudbeck, Gene Schwede, and Rich Lutz.  
Others Present: Brian J. Schlote, Andy Mohr, Thomas DeMoss.

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Wehrer called meeting to order. Roll call taken: Wehrer, Sudbeck, Riedel, Schwede, and Lutz in attendance. Kelley absent. Wehrer informed public as to current copy and public accessibility of Open Meetings Act. Motion made by Lutz to accept the October minutes, second by Schwede. All in favor. Motion carried. Motion made by Riedel to accept official treasurer report, second by Sudbeck. All in favor. Motion carried. Thomas DeMoss from the Diamond Dawgs was present to discuss the updates on the baseball field. In order for the field to be 4" to 6" of top soil, they would need another 50 tons of Aggregate delivered. Discussed reseeding and installing sprinkles in the outfield after baseball season has ended. Motion made by Lutz to purchase and ship 50 tons of Aggregate for the baseball field from Bryan Rock, second by Sudbeck. All in favor. Motion carried. Discussed a concession stand with food and drinks. Riedel will ask Dave Cummings from the Village Inn if he is interested in doing this. They are looking for players that are 8 years old with a birth date before May 1<sup>st</sup> and younger. Discussed the 2014-2015 Tree Project. Motion made by Riedel to pay the 25% of the project costs of \$3,872.62 plus \$1,800.00 for addition tree removals outside of the project, second by Schwede. All in favor. Motion carried. Motion made by Riedel to purchase #5 (N-95) breathing masks for the Hadar Rural Fire Dept. at the cost of \$65.00 a piece, second by Sudbeck. All in favor. Motion carried. Motion made by Lutz to purchase a \$25.00 gift certificate for each employee from Village Inn that will be given at the appreciation dinner on Dec 6<sup>th</sup> at 6:00pm, second by Schwede. All in favor. Motion carried. Discussed the radar speed display sign. Lutz tabled the purchase of one until more information can be collected, such as the cost to maintain it. The one located along NE-13 at this time was borrowed from the NE Dept. of Roads for a few weeks. Chad Anderson was not present to discuss housing developments. Discussed the Village of Hadar's delinquent sewer bills. Motion made by Lutz to replace the push bar on the north west door at the Fire Hall and the north steal door on the west of the Community Building, second by Schwede. All in favor. Motion carried. Discussed the village having the Sheriff Dept. police the town, which was tabled. Riedel informed the board that the walking path at the park has been re coated after the cracks were cleaned out. Schwede stated that Peterson Sprinklers blew out the sprinklers at the park and Fire Hall. Schwede also asked Ellenberger to mow the banks at the lagoon. Sudbeck reported that the sewer reports should be in this week and the Christmas welcome banners have been hung. Schwede stated he wants to start grinding the restroom floors at the park this week. Lutz had nothing to report on animal control.
