Board Members Present: Mark Craft, Robert Wehrer, Sidney Sudbeck, Myron Wasson, Dillion Kraft. Others Present: Gene Schwede, Gary Schuett.

Craft called meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Roll call taken: Bob Wehrer, Sid Sudbeck, Myron Wasson, Dillion Kraft, and Mark Craft present.

Motion made by Wehrer to accept April minutes as written and seconded by Wasson. All in favor. Motion carried. Clerk Linda Spreeman read the official treasurer report for April. Motion made by Sudbeck to accept April's official treasurer's report, seconded by Kraft. All in favor. Motion carried.

Old Business:

Craft gave a FEMA update – Been in contact with JEO and Brent with M & B Quality Concrete L.L.C. about 847th and being into summer. Mentioned that we had until September 1 to be done and paid up. Waiting on State of Nebraska to start Hadar Road. Everything was signed and sealed.

New Business:

Craft discussed insurance policy and after reviewing areas, just to insure roof on block building and updating comprehensive and liability to cover for any volunteer work done for the Village of Hadar.

Sudbeck put in for a grant for two extra camper pads and a basketball court. Grant was approved for the camper pads for the 2022 budget and not the basketball court, but can apply again for a court in the future. Signed paperwork was to be returned by May 20th. Project to be completed by June 15th, 2022. A motion was made by Wasson to continuing with pursuing grant for two camper pads. Motion was seconded by Kraft. All in favor. Motion carried.

Wehrer brought up the RC&D board would man a dumpster for household hazards waste/electronic recycling the fall of 2021. Dumpster would cost \$250.00 After discussion a motion was made by Sudbeck to have a dumpster this fall for \$250.00 for household hazards waste/electronic recycling. Wasson seconded the motion. All in favor, Motion carried.

Department Updates:

Fire Hall Update: Gary Schuett – Project is a lot closer, electrical inspection had been done, waiting a couple other items, valves and well control. Talked about the flooring, trim in some areas, repairing and cleaning up. Schuett also mentioned Rural Fire Board meeting on May 13th at 7:00 for anyone interested. Schuett also asked the board about the bell in front of the existing fire hall. Craft said if the fire department wants the bell at the new place to go ahead and plan to move it and if not, it could be left at existing place. The key pad at existing fire hall, after discussion, was decided to leave it.

Wehrer – Street project is looking at the end of May to start, there was issues with the asphalt plant and product delaying projects. Said the Bargain Byway went well, had quite a few committed for next year. Hunter Raabe was the Keno Scholarship winner for 2021. ECAP, had 7 people for steering committee.

Sudbeck – Was approved for a grant for funding to add additional camper pads to the park. Obrist was to be in Hadar on Tuesday or Wednesday the week of May 10th for schedule work on sewer work.

Wasson – Nothing new, but the bathrooms are now open and campers and staying and using camper pads. Immanuel Lutheran School students did work at the park through a grant, painting, power washing restrooms and other areas of the park. Board members thanked the students for their great work in improving Hadar's park.

Kraft – Has had no phone calls for animal control. Did mention that there has been foxes running throughout Hadar.
