Board Members Present: Robert Wehrer, Sid Sudbeck, Myron Wasson, Dillion Kraft arrived at 6:34 PM and Mark Craft.

Craft called meeting to order at 6:30 PM. Craft stated this was an open meeting of the Hadar Village Board and the poster with the Open Meetings Act is displayed and accessible to the public in the front of the room. Roll call taken: Bob Wehrer, Sid Sudbeck, Dillion Kraft arrived at 6:34 PM and Mark Craft.

Motion made by Wasson to accept May minutes as written and seconded by Wehrer. All in favor. Motion carried. Clerk Bauermeister read the official treasurer report for May. Motion made by Sudbeck to accept May's official treasurer's report, seconded by Wasson. All in favor. Motion carried.

Department Updates:

Wehrer – Speed Sign when entering the Village of Hadar was fixed by Mark Craft. Thank you Mark Craft for making these repairs.

Sudbeck – The fence posts around the lagoon need to be replaced and Craft is gathering bids at this time.

Wasson – A bench in memory of Lois Raasch has been purchased and being donated to the Hadar park. The Village will take care of the concrete pad required to place the bench and will make arrangements once the bench has been received. Thank you to Fisher Tree service for donating tree chips to cover the playground at the park.

New Business:

The 1 & 6 year plan was presented to the board members for review and will be updated and approved at the September 2025 meeting.

The Preliminary Municipal Code books have been completed and presented to each board member for review and will be discussed for approval during the August 2025 meeting.

Amber & Heath Vogel is requesting usage of the Hadar office building, the smaller carpeted side once a month, during the week, free of charge for their silent book club. Motion made by Kraft to allow the Vogel's to use the carpeted side of the Hadar Offices building free of charge, during the week at no charge, and to not interfere and work around the schedule of other hall renters during the week and monthly meetings and seconded by Sudbeck. All in favor. Motion carried. Cathy Schutt who handles hall rentals will be notified of this approval.
