Board Members Present: Robert Wehrer, Sid Sudbeck, Myron Wasson, Dillion Kraft and Mark Craft.

Others Present: Gene Schwede & Bob Huntley.

Craft called meeting to order at 6:30 PM. Craft stated this was an open meeting of the Hadar Village Board and the poster with the Open Meetings Act is displayed and accessible to the public in the front of the room. Roll call taken: Bob Wehrer, Sid Sudbeck, Myron Wasson, Dillion Kraft and Mark Craft.

Motion made by Wasson to accept June minutes as written and seconded by Sudbeck. All in favor. Motion carried. Clerk Bauermeister read the official treasurer report for June. Motion made by Wehrer to accept June's official treasurer's report, seconded by Wasson. All in favor. Motion carried.

The Midwest Bank CD ending in 5629 is up for renewal. A motion to renew the Midwest Bank CD ending in 5629 for 6 months at a 4.07% interest rate was made by Wasson, seconded by Kraft. All in favor. Motion carried.

Department Updates:

Wehrer – The state came to clean out storm drains but work is still needed. Wehrer will reach out to the State to have them properly cleaned out. The work to be completed on the roads by Asphalt 316 is scheduled to begin at the end of July. While they are here, they will provide a quote to improve the park walking path.

Sudbeck – Craft is still gathering bids to replace the fence posts and replace the gate at the Lagoon.

Wasson – The bench to be placed in memory of Lois Raasch has been delivered and work by Sudbeck will be done to put in the concrete pad to place the bench in the park. Wasson & Kraft are working together to apply and obtain a grant to get up to 10 trees to be planted in the park.

Kraft – Dog License fee collected and presented to the clerk.

New Business:

A reminder to the board members that the Annual budget hearing is approaching and will be addressed in August and September 2025.

Board Member Salaries - Motion made by Wasson to keep Board member salaries the same and increase the employee's salaries by 3.5% beginning October 2025 and seconded by Kraft. Vote: (Roll Call) Those in favor, Sudbeck, Wasson, Craft & Kraft, those opposed Wehrer. Motion carried.
