Board Members Present: Robert Wehrer, Myron Wasson, Dillion Kraft and Mark Craft.

Craft called meeting to order at 6:30 PM. Craft stated this was an open meeting of the Hadar Village Board and the poster with the Open Meetings Act is displayed and accessible to the public in the front of the room. Roll call taken: Bob Wehrer, Myron Wasson, Dillion Kraft and Mark Craft. Sid Sudbeck – Absent.

Motion made by Wasson to accept July minutes as written and seconded by Kraft. All in favor. Motion carried. Clerk Bauermeister read the official treasurer report for July. Motion made by Wehrer to accept July's official treasurer's report, seconded by Wasson. All in favor. Motion carried.

Department Updates:

Wehrer – The work to be completed on the roads by Asphalt 316 has been delayed due to the amount of rain. Gene mentioned we need more flag poles and Craft is in the process of ordering more. The Horse shoe tournament was a huge success and was covered by News Channel Nebraska.

Wasson – Wasson successfully applied to obtain a grant to get up to 10 trees to be planted in the park and the awardees will be announced August 14th. Several boards were replaced on the benches in park near the concessions. Quakes softball team would like to make the Hadar field their home field. Further discussion is tabled for next month to get more details.

New Business:

Bob Huntley's sign – Craft is still working through the paperwork to get this approved.

Municipal Code Changes & Updates will be reviewed in entirety at the September 15th, 2025 meeting.

Ordinances:

Ordinance 20251108 concerning Speed Zones and a motion to waive three readings was made by Wasson, seconded by Wehrer. All in favor. Motion Carried. Section 3-120 A sets a rate of speed greater than 25 miles per hour within the residential district and 20 miles per hour within the business district unless a different rate of speed is specifically permitted by ordinance. Section 3-120 B states that no person shall operate a motor vehicle on Nebraska State Highway No. 13 within the corporate limits of the Village of Hadar, Nebraska, between 554th Avenue to the west corporate limits of 847th Road in excess of 35 miles per hour. A motion to approve was made by Kraft, seconded by Wasson. All in favor. Motion Carried.

Resolutions:

Resolution No. 20251108A Signing of the Municipal Annual Certification of Program Compliance 2025. Read by Craft. A motion to move forward was made by Wehrer and Seconded by Wasson. Roll Call Vote in Favor: Wehrer, Wasson, Kraft, & Craft. Sudbeck Absent. All in Favor. Motion Carried.

Annual Budget:

A motion was made by Kraft to continue with the regular 3.5% Sewer Rate increase and seconded by Wasson. All in Favor. Motion Carried.

ORDINANCE NO. 20251108

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3-120: SPEED ZONES FOUND IN ARTICLE 1 - TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, CHAPTER 3 - VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC; TO REPEAL ANY ORDINANCE IN CONFLICT THEREIN; AND TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRPERSON AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF HADAR, PIERCE COUNTY, NEBRASKA TO AMEND SECTION 3-120: SPEED ZONES FOUND IN ARTICLE 1 - TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, CHAPTER 3 - VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC OF THE VILLAGE CODE TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.

ARTICLE 1- TRAFFIC REGULATIONS SECTION 3-120:

SPEED ZONES

A. No person shall operate a motor vehicle on any street, alley, or other place at a rate of speed greater than 25 miles per hour within the residential district and 20 miles per hour within the business district, unless a different rate of speed is specifically permitted by ordinance. In no instance shall a person drive a vehicle on a highway at a speed greater than is reasonable and prudent under the conditions. Where a different maximum speed is set by ordinance, appropriate signs shall be posted.

B. No person shall operate a motor vehicle on the Nebraska State Highway No. 13 within the corporate limits of the Village of Hadar, Nebraska, from the east corporate limits at AA Street (554th Avenue) to the west corporate limits 160 northwest of 847th Road, in excess of 35 miles per hour.

Section 2. Any other Ordinance or Section passed or approved prior to the passage, approval, and publication or posting of this Ordinance or in any conflict with the Ordinance is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and shall be in full force from and after its passage, approval, publication or posting as required by law.
