Board Members Present: Robert Wehrer, Sid Sudbeck, Myron Wasson, and Mark Craft.

Board Members Absent at Roll Call: Dillion Kraft (arrived at 6:53 PM)

Others Present: Gene Schwede, Cami Harper, and Blake Eisenmann.

Craft called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM and stated this was an open meeting of the Hadar Village Board. The poster with the Open Meetings Act is displayed and accessible to the public in the front of the room.

Motion by Wasson, seconded by Sudbeck, to approve the February minutes as written. Kraft absent. All in favor. Motion carried.

Clerk Bauermeister read the official Treasurer's Report for February.

Motion by Sudbeck, seconded by Wasson, to approve the February Treasurer's Report. Kraft absent. All in favor. Motion carried.

Department Updates:

Wehrer – Gene Schwede completed a list of street signs to be replaced. Wehrer will begin contacting businesses regarding production and installation Bargain Buy-Way is scheduled for April 24–25. Spots are still available.

Sudbeck – Sewer testing is scheduled to take place on Friday, March 13, 2026.

Wasson – Gene Schwede and Wasson watered the newly planted trees at the park and worked on removing corn husks that had blown into the ball field and park areas.

Craft – Work is continuing to install two new sirens. They will be controlled and tested monthly by the local fire department, where the CB transmitter will be located.

New Business:

Cami Harper, representing the Quakes softball team, attended the meeting and submitted payment for use of the softball field for the season. A schedule of games and practices will be provided and posted at the field. Harper also stated the team is seeking a grant to assist with beautifying the field and is planning a team cleanup day to help prepare the field.

Blake Eisenmann with JEO attended the meeting and presented maps and plans for the proposed street repair project within the Village of Hadar. Upon approval of the plans and specifications presented, the project will be advertised for bids in the Norfolk Daily News. Bids will be opened and presented at the April board meeting.

Motion by Wasson, seconded by Kraft, to approve the plans and specifications presented by JEO and move forward with advertising for bids. All in favor. Motion carried.

Sudbeck Lot Split: A lot split for Sudbeck was presented to the board. Chairman Craft and Clerk Bauermeister signed the lot split.

Motion by Wasson, seconded by Kraft, to approve the Sudbeck lot split. Sudbeck abstained. All other members voted in favor. Motion carried.

Lagoon Repairs: The board reviewed an estimate from Fischer Tree Central to replace bent and broken posts at the lagoon.

Motion by Wasson, seconded by Wehrer, to approve the estimate from Fischer Tree Central. Kraft abstained due to employment with Fischer Tree Central. All other members voted in favor. Motion carried.

Certificate of Deposit: The board discussed a Certificate of Deposit ending in 3338 with Midwest Bank that is maturing.

Motion by Wehrer, seconded by Sudbeck, to authorize Clerk Bauermeister to contact Midwest Bank to obtain the best available rate for the maturing CD. All in favor. Motion carried.

Other Business:

Information was shared regarding upcoming training opportunities. No action was taken.
