Board Members Present: Robert Wehrer, Sid Sudbeck, Dillion Kraft, and Mark Craft.

Board Members Absent: Myron Wasson

Others Present: Gene Schwede and Blake Eisenmann.

Craft called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM and stated this was an open meeting of the Hadar Village Board. The poster with the Open Meetings Act is displayed and accessible to the public in the front of the room.

Motion by Wehrer, seconded by Sudbeck, to approve the March minutes as written. All in favor. Motion carried.

Clerk Bauermeister read the official Treasurer's Report for March. Motion by Sudbeck, seconded by Wehrer, to approve the March Treasurer's Report. All in favor. Motion carried.

Department Updates:

Wehrer – Gary Schuett was contacted by a 10 & under team that would like to do some cleanup at the Hadar ball field May 2nd. Volunteer forms will need to be completed by adults participating. They will collaborate with Gene Schwede and Myron Wasson to complete the cleanup and work on cleaning up the storage room at the ball field. Repairs to the water heater may be needed at the ball field may also be needed, and Mark Craft will look into this further. A cribbage tournament is scheduled for June 14th. Sudbeck – Sewer testing has been completed as scheduled and everything passed.

Kraft – A dog was found and taken to the shelter to be claimed. Kraft is also working with Meadow Grove, which recently received a grant to help improve the trees and nature of their park. Kraft was provided with a contact to assist with a possible future grant for the Village of Hadar and will work with Wasson to make contact.

Craft – Work is continuing to install two new sirens.

Street Repairs: Blake Eisenmann with JEO attended the meeting and presented two bids for the street repair project within the Village of Hadar. A preconstruction meeting will be held, with a proposed date of Monday, April 27th at 7:00 PM.

Motion by Kraft, seconded by Sudbeck, to approve the bid presented by Knife River in the amount of \$92,685.22 and move forward with the street project.

Roll call vote: Wehrer – YES, Sudbeck – YES, Kraft – YES, Craft – YES.

All in favor. Motion carried. Wasson – Absent.

Lagoon Repairs: Fischer Tree Central replaced the broken posts and gate at the lagoon.

Other Business: Judith Stanton has taken the position as the new Director for the Pierce County Economic Development. The Village of Hadar will be compiling a list of community improvements.

Motion by Wehrer, seconded by Kraft to appoint Daryl Kollars as an alternative representative for the Village of Hadar to attend PCED meetings. All in favor, motion carried.

Discussion was held regarding a bill presented to the board by Deb Elsberry from Johnson's, Inc. Plumbing & Heating. Motion by Kraft, seconded by Sudbeck, to refuse the bill. All in favor. Motion carried.
